

## *We make the world's finest music, available to all.*

We are a group of people who love music and who come together to create wonderful musical performances for the community in South Australia. We are not a commercial enterprise, rather a community organisation comprised of volunteers, which exists to bring joy to audiences - not profits for shareholders. Hence, we rely solely upon the support of sponsors to provide financial sustenance, along with any net proceeds from performances we put on.

The beautiful music we perform (romantic Italian songs, opera and 'easy listening' English ballads) when produced by commercial bands are typically very expensive to buy tickets to attend, because the size of a choir (some 50 members), the instrumentalists, the quality and size of the venue needed (e.g. Adelaide Festival Centre), and the years of paid musical rehearsals, production crew along with the conductors and musical Directors required, make staging our type of events, very costly. The public therefore, pay steep ticket prices to attend such events when they are staged by commercial companies.

Ozitalian Choir however, is a community based producer of these events whose volunteers put on the same shows, but without the commercial costs involved; hence, we make those same incredible musical experiences accessible to all South Australians at a fraction of the cost of commercial companies. We make it possible for families to bring their kids, for young couples and retired people to attend live performances regularly, and for those on normal incomes to experience the power and emotion of a large choir often.

We are keeping alive the very best of Italian musical culture, in South Australia. Our mission is to meticulously preserve the authenticity and faithfully recreate with every performance, the character of the original Italian songs, so our 2026 Adelaide audiences enjoy the same experience that the 1726 Milan audiences enjoyed. Our conductor and many in the group are either Italian, or studied Italian language...hence, all choir members and all those who attend our events, can have full confidence this living history is brought to life with fidelity.

Beautiful, fine music can only exist for future generations, if our kids and young families have live exposure to it...and live exposure requires live performances that are accessible to South Australians. That's the role we play.

## *Call for musicians and singers to join Ozitalian in 2026*

More musicians and singers are invited to join the premier community choir in South Australia. Ozitalian Choir is a well established, professionally lead choral group that performs the world's most loved operatic and popular Italian and English romantic songs of all time, to adoring audiences at large events, throughout the year.


Under the musical direction of conductor il maestro Mario Bellanova, our choir members and instrumentalists enjoy the privilege of learning the world's best singing techniques directly from the maestro who studied opera and voice in the great universities of Italy and Europe where he grew up and performed professionally. New choir members are now being sought to expand our size even further. Openings exist both for musicians (instrumentalists must have a reasonable level of playing skill), as well as for singers (no experience is necessary for vocalists, but some competence is highly regarded).

We invite male and female singers of all ages, of all ranges and from all styles to join our choir. We also invite musicians from any musical instrument group: including stringed instruments (guitarist, violins, cellos, double bass and harpists etc.), plus brass players (trombone, flugelhorn, cornett, French horn, tuba, trumpets etc.), plus woodwind/reed instruments (saxophones, clarinet, flutes, horns, bassoon, oboe etc.), plus percussionists (vibraphones, xylophone, drums, cymbals, marimba, timpani, bells, glockenspiel, tambourine, chimes, güiro, claves, wind chimes, timbales, congas, cabasa etc.). Keyboard players such as harpsichordists, pianists, accordions and organists all also welcome.

Ozitalian rehearses weekly throughout the year (except holiday periods) and is comprised of many wonderful individuals who love music and who like to build friendships and perform beautiful music to appreciative crowds. Rehearsals are conducted on weekday evenings and occur in the great comfort of our modern, fully air-conditioned hall with excellent acoustics and amenities on Grange Rd at Kidman Park. A full, new PA system is supplied at every rehearsal - so there's no need for you to lug your own.

Full onsite parking, toilets and kitchen facilities are included. Members are supplied the music and professional instruction they need to grow as vocalists and instrumentalists, in a nurturing and friendly environment. Every person is encouraged to improve and grow in a kind and supportive manner; and of course, every performance fills every member with immense pleasure and satisfaction. Many of the group's performances are professionally filmed and turned into documentaries that raise the profile of all members of the Ozitalian choir.

Ozitalian works collaboratively with other musical groups, cultural associations, and arts bodies who have complementary missions in the furthering of the arts, of music and of culture, who would like to develop joint performances or projects. We are always growing new relationships with other musical groups in South Australia, as well as with cultural organisations, schools, Universities, hotels, the media, publishers, event organisers, government agencies, and other committees who explore with us, ideas for collaboration and public performances.

The Ozitalian Community Choir has full commercial, marketing and media production capabilities within its internal structure, therefore has the capacity to bring to fruition even large ideas with partners that collaborate with us. ## *Our Audiences: A Profile of who you're Performing to.*

Our audiences are comprised of individuals with sophisticated musical tastes that correlate with a higher demographic. Opera, traditional Italian love songs and English 'easy listening/big band' standards lean towards the listening repertoire of those with a larger worldview, whom carry greater social and business influence. Our audiences tend to be more educated with a well developed appreciation of culture, and partake in refined experiences with their friendship groups. These people represent the most lucrative target for exposure to, and establish a relationship with.

Our choir members appreciate that for sponsors, reaching these audiences is often difficult, and commercially expensive, as media designed to target this demographic, such as *Vogue*, are not economically viable (they cost thousands for just one edition), with little or no repeat exposure. Sponsorships with commercial groups in SA are prohibitive, such as the State Theatre Company (\$10,000 per season), or the State Opera (up to \$20,000). Ozitalian however, provides a low cost, alternative for organisations to reach the same audiences, making Ozitalian an attractive proposition for sponsors, resulting in sustainable financial support for our choir to continue serving its members and the community. And for sponsors (and choir members), it provides multiple impressions per year, with each exposure lasting hours, allowing to build relationships with key people between arts and business worlds.



## *The Positive Context in which Ozitalian Choir is Enjoyed.*

Our audiences and sponsors are relaxed, happy and brimming with anticipation to watch you perform, every time they arrive at our events.

Almost all of our concerts include fine dining in the company of good friends. The audience's exposure to yourself as a vocalist or musician, and Ozitalian as a brand, is always in a positive context. You'll be building goodwill, while giving tremendous joy contributing to the social landscape in which South Australians live and raise their families. And each impression we make with the thousands of people who see us is never fleeting, but lasts an entire afternoon or evening, which in turn repeats a number of times per year at every subsequent Ozitalian event.

By joining our choir you will contribute to the psychological and emotional wellbeing of our fellow South Australians - through your singing, through your playing - as they find relief from their life pressures.
